# NBC-2012

The organizing committee is please to extend a cordial invitation to attend National Brassica Conference 2012 on "Production Barriers & Technological Options in Oilseed Brassica" at CCS HAU, Hisar during March 2-3, 2012.

## THEME OF THE CONFERENCE :

In India, rapeseed-mustard crop are predominantly grown in marginal soils of diverse agro-climatic regions. There the crop is subjected to the furry of nature in the form of drought, unfavourable heavy rains and floods, and thus faces uncertainty of acreage and biotic stresses. Of late, the rise in temperature, shrinking winters and shift in winter rain pattern due to climate change has complicated the fragile energy and mass exchange equilibrium to further aggravate the enigma of mustard farmers and emerging a major bio-risk factor. The biology, behavior and epidemiology of existing and new insect-pest and diseases are getting influenced and affecting the production and income of the farmers. Further, small and fragmented oil processing sector and half hearted support from critical input industries added to the treacheries of the mustard producers.

Under present changing climate situations, the self sufficiency in rapeseed-mustard production could only be achieved through integration of farmers, policy planners, academicians, researchers, input and oilseed processing sectors to harness the benefit of generated technologies and harmonize and synergize future efforts of all stakeholders. On this back drop, the present conference will have a special focus on recent advances in rapeseed-mustard production

technology, sharing the experiences of stake holders and develop guidelines for future research.

- Hybrid breeding successes and challenges for the future
- Biotechnological interventions for stress management
- Quality improvement and Value added products in Brassica
- Resource utilization through integrated cropping system

- Public-private partnership for rapeseed-mustard development

**About Hisar :** Hisar is 164 kilometers west to Delhi on the National Highway 10. Historically it was founded by Muslim ruler, Firozshah Tughlaq in 1354 A.D. but remains of pre-Harappan settlements at Agroha, Banawali and Kunal; presence of Emperor Ashoka's pillar (234 A.D.) at Hisar fort and coins of the Kushan Kings signifies historical importance of the city.
